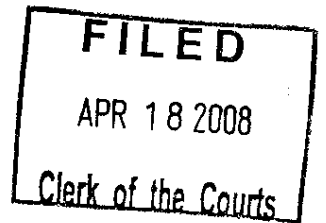

ORDER OF ENFORCEMENT

The Board of Professional Responsibility of the Supreme Court of Tennessee ("the Board"), by and through Disciplinary Counsel, filed a Petition for Discipline against the Respondent, Jeffrey A. Smith.


Pursuant to Section 16.1 of Tennessee Supreme Court Rule 9, Respondent submitted a Conditional Guilty Plea in exchange for a stated form of discipline. The stated form of discipline is that Respondent shall be publicly censured.

A copy of the Conditional Guilty Plea, which has been approved by the Board, is attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein.

It is, therefore, **ORDERED, ADJUDGED** and **DECREED** that:

1. Respondent is publicly censured for his violation of Rule of Professional Conduct 5.3.
2. Respondent, Jeffrey A. Smith, shall pay the costs in this matter of \$414.00, and in addition, shall pay the Clerk of this Court the costs incurred herein, for all of which execution shall issue, if necessary.
