## ORDER OF TEMPORARY SUSPENSION

This matter is before the Court on a Petition of the Board of Professional Responsibility of the Supreme Court of Tennessee, by and through Disciplinary Counsel, for the temporary suspension of Daniel Rafael Solla from the practice of law, pursuant to Section 4.3 of Supreme Court Rule 9. The Petition has been authorized by the Chair of the Board of Professional Responsibility and is supported by the affidavit of Elizabeth C. Garber, Disciplinary Counsel.

Based upon the Petition, and the supporting Affidavits, the Court finds that the continued practice of law by Daniel Rafael Solla poses a threat of substantial harm to the public.

It is therefore, **ORDERED**, **ADJUDGED** and **DECREED** by the Court that:

- 1. Daniel Rafael Solla is hereby temporarily suspended from the practice of law as provided in Section 4.3 of Supreme Court Rule 9.
- 2. Daniel Rafael Solla shall comply with Supreme Court Rule 9 in all respects, and particularly as provided in Section 18.
- 3. Daniel Rafael Solla may make application for dissolution or modification of this Order as provided in Supreme Court Rule 9.
- 4. The Board of Professional Responsibility shall cause notice of this suspension of Daniel Rafael Solla to be published as required by Supreme Court Rule 9.
