MEMPHIS LAWYER PUBLICLY CENSURED

Paul J. Springer, Sr., of Memphis, was publicly censured by the Board of Professional Responsibility on May 19, 2006. The censure was issued by the Board pursuant to Rule 9, Section 8 of the Rules of the Tennessee Supreme Court. Springer did not request a hearing on the matter.

In one complaint filed against Springer as appointed counsel by the Tennessee Court of Criminal Appeals, the Board found that he grossly neglected three appeals which were pending with the Court between 2004 and 2005. In each of these appeals, Springer was exceedingly dilatory and failed to file his brief despite being granted 3-4 extensions of time by the Court in each of these cases over nearly 6 months between the Spring and Fall of 2005.

Springer was adjudged to be in willful contempt pursuant to September 20, 2005 orders of the Court of Criminal Appeals in each of these cases and was discharged as counsel. However, he failed to pay the \$50 fine and costs assessed against him in each of these matters by October 20, 2005 as ordered, and did so only after a subsequent show cause order issued setting a hearing on November 15, 2005 for his failure to comply.

The Board also concluded that Springer had failed to comply with both the orders of the Tennessee Court of Criminal Appeals and the Tennessee Rules of Appellate Procedure. In mitigation, the Board found that Springer had practiced law for only a few years and that the instances of neglect involved in these cases appeared to be limited to a specific period of time in 2005.
