**AGREED ORDER FOR VOLUNTARY TRANSFER
TO DISABILITY INACTIVE STATUS**

Comes now, George Russell Stanton, Jr., by and through his attorney, Fred M. Acuff, Jr., pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 9, Section 21, who moves the Court for an Order of Voluntary Transfer to Disability Inactive Status, until such time the Court may find that Petitioner should be returned to active status for the practice of law. This Order is supported by the opinion of Kenneth F. Tullis, a licensed psychiatrist. See Collective Exhibit A. The Board of Professional Responsibility, by and through Disciplinary Counsel, agrees to this transfer.

It is further **ORDERED** that Petitioner, George Russell Stanton, Jr., shall pay to the Clerk of this Court the costs incurred herein, for all of which execution shall issue, if necessary.
