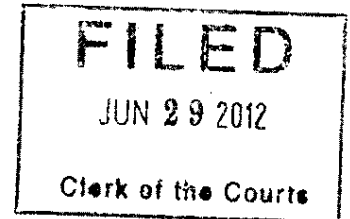

ORDER OF TEMPORARY SUSPENSION

This matter is before the Court on a Petition of the Board of Professional Responsibility of the Supreme Court of Tennessee, by and through Disciplinary Counsel, for the temporary suspension of Jeffrey Andrew Stinnett from the practice of law, pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 4.3. The Petition has been authorized by the Chair of the Board of Professional Responsibility and is supported by the affidavit of Preston Shipp, Disciplinary Counsel.

Based upon the Petition and the supporting Affidavit, the Court finds that Jeffrey Andrew Stinnett has failed to respond to Disciplinary Counsel's request for additional information and has failed to respond to an initial complaint from the Board of Professional Responsibility concerning two complaints of misconduct.

It is therefore, ordered, adjudged, and decreed by the Court that:

1. Jeffrey Andrew Stinnett is hereby temporarily suspended from the practice of law as provided in Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 4.3.
2. Jeffrey Andrew Stinnett shall comply with Tennessee Supreme Court Rule 9 in all respects, and particularly as provided in Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 18.
3. Jeffrey Andrew Stinnett may make application for dissolution or modification of this Order as provided in Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 4.3.
4. The Board of Professional Responsibility shall cause notice of this suspension of Jeffrey Andrew Stinnett to be published as required by Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 18.10.
