ORDER

This matter is before the Court upon a Petition for Discipline filed by the Board of Professional Responsibility ("Board") against Respondent, Jeffrey A. Stinnett; upon Respondent's oral Conditional Guilty Plea; and upon the entire record in this cause.

From all of which the Court accepts Respondent's Conditional Guilty Plea and concludes that Respondent's agreement to a four (4) month suspension for practicing law while administratively suspended for noncompliance with continuing legal education requirements as set forth in Rule 21, § 3.01 of the Rules of the Supreme Court is appropriate.

It is, therefore, **ORDERED, ADJUDGED** and **DECREED** by the Court that:

1. Respondent be and is hereby suspended for four (4) months.
2. Respondent shall comply in all aspects with Rule 9, § 18 of the Rules of the Supreme Court regarding the obligations and responsibilities of suspended attorneys.
3. Pursuant to Rule 9, § 24.3 of the Rules of the Supreme Court, Respondent shall pay to the Board the expenses and costs of this matter in the amount of \$882.69, and in addition, shall pay the clerk of this Court the costs incurred herein, for all of which execution may issue if necessary.
4. The Board shall cause notice of this suspension to be published as required by Rule 9, § 18.10 of the Rules of the Supreme Court.
