ORDER

This matter is before the Court upon a Petition for Discipline filed by the Board of Professional Responsibility ("Board") against Respondent, Jeffrey A. Stinnett; upon Respondent's oral Conditional Guilty Plea; and upon the entire record in this cause.

From all of which the Court accepts Respondent's Conditional Guilty Plea and concludes that Respondent's agreement to a four (4) month suspension for practicing law while administratively suspended for noncompliance with continuing legal education requirements as set forth in Rule 21, § 3.01 of the Rules of the Supreme Court is appropriate.

It is, therefore, ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED by the Court that:

- 1. Respondent be and is hereby suspended for four (4) months.
- 2. Respondent shall comply in all aspects with Rule 9, § 18 of the Rules of the Supreme Court regarding the obligations and responsibilities of suspended attorneys.
- 3. Pursuant to Rule 9, § 24.3 of the Rules of the Supreme Court, Respondent shall pay to the Board the expenses and costs of this matter in the amount of \$882.69, and in addition, shall pay the clerk of this Court the costs incurred herein, for all of which execution may issue if necessary.
- 4. The Board shall cause notice of this suspension to be published as required by Rule 9, § 18.10 of the Rules of the Supreme Court.
