**ORDER OF ENFORCEMENT**

This matter is before the Court upon a Petition for Discipline filed on April 1, 2009, upon a Conditional Guilty Plea entered by Respondent on August 3, 2009; upon a Hearing Panel Order recommending approval of the Conditional Guilty Plea entered on August 5, 2009, and approval by the Board on September 11, 2009; and upon the entire record in this cause.

From all of which the Court accepts the recommendation of the Hearing Panel and concludes that the Conditional Guilty Plea imposing a nine month suspension retroactive to the Respondent's temporary suspension on January 29, 2009, is appropriate.

It is therefore, **ORDERED, ADJUDGED** and **DECREED** by the Court:

1. That the Respondent, Jeffrey A. Stinnett, is suspended for nine months, retroactive to the Respondent's temporary suspension on January 29, 2009. This order supercedes and dissolves the order entered January 29, 2009.
2. That pursuant to Rule 9, § 24.3 of the Rules of the Supreme Court, the Respondent shall pay to the Board of Professional Responsibility the expenses and costs of this matter in the amount of \$178.92, and in addition, shall pay the clerk of this Court the costs incurred herein, payment of both of which shall be a condition of reinstatement, for all of which execution may issue if necessary; and
3. The Board of Professional Responsibility and the Respondent shall cause all required notice(s) of this discipline to be given or published, and shall otherwise comply with all requirements of Supreme Court Rule 9, Section 18.
4. Reinstatement of the Respondent to the practice of law in Tennessee shall be governed by the provisions of Supreme Court Rule 9, Section 19.



5. Pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 9, Section 18.5, this Order shall be effective immediately.
