PUBLIC CENSURE

The Respondent represents the Complainant's son, in his divorce. While the Respondent was out of town in February, 2006, a default judgment was entered against his client. More than thirty (30) days passed prior to the Respondent's learning of the default judgment. The Complainant states the Respondent never advised the Complainant or the Complainant's son of the default. The Respondent violated Rules 1.3; 1.4; 3.2 and 8.4(a)(d) of the Tennessee Rules of Professional Conduct by neglecting his client's case and failing to communicate with his client. The Respondent acknowledges the client is entitled to a full refund of his fee, however, the Respondent has failed to provide any such refund in violation of Rule 1.5 of the Tennessee Rules of Professional Conduct.
