**ORDER**

This matter is before the Court upon the filing of a complaint with the Board of Professional Responsibility, as to the notices of these complaints mailed to the Respondent at the address where she is registered with the Board of Professional Responsibility, upon the Respondent's failure to answer these notices, upon the approval of the Chair of the Board of Professional Responsibility for Disciplinary Counsel to file with this Court a Petition for the Temporary Suspension of Respondent's law license as a result of her failure to respond to the complaint and upon the filing by Disciplinary Counsel of this Petition, pursuant to Section 4.3 of Rule 9, Rules of the Supreme Court of Tennessee.


This Court finds that Respondent has failed to respond to a complaint filed with the Board of Professional Responsibility and that as a result the Respondent's law license should be suspended pursuant to Sec. 4.3, Rule 9, Rules of the Supreme Court.

It is therefore **ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED** by the Court that:

1. Respondent, Linda Sesson Taylor, is hereby temporarily suspended from the practice of law as provided in Section 4.3, Rule 9 of the Rules of the Tennessee Supreme Court.
2. Respondent, Linda Sesson Taylor, shall comply with Supreme Court Rule 9 in all respects and, particularly, as provided in Section 18.
3. Respondent, Linda Sesson Taylor, may make application for dissolution or modification of this Order as provided in Rule 9.
4. Respondent shall pay the costs of the Board in this matter pursuant to Rule 9, Section 24.3 of the Tennessee Supreme Court Rules. In addition, Respondent shall pay the costs imposed by the Clerk of this Court, for all of which execution shall issue, if necessary.

5. That the Board of Professional Responsibility shall cause notice of this suspension to be published in compliance with Tennessee Supreme Court Rule 9, Sections 18.5 and 18.6.
