ORDER OF REINSTATEMENT

This matter is before the Court, pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 30.4(d), upon a Petition for Reinstatement filed on October 7, 2022, by the Petitioner, Capp Peterson Taylor. Mr. Taylor was suspended from the practice of law by Order of this Court on December 19, 2017, and January 8, 2020. The Report and Recommendation of Hearing Committee Panel was entered on April 10, 2023, recommending Mr. Taylor be reinstated. Findings and Judgment for Assessment of Costs was entered May 16, 2023. The Report and Recommendation of Hearing Committee Panel and the Findings and Judgment for Assessment of Costs were considered and approved by the Board on June 9, 2023.

From all of which the Court approves the Report and Recommendation of Hearing Committee Panel and the Findings and Judgment for Assessment of Costs and adopts the same as this Court's Order.

- IT IS, THEREFORE, CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED BY THE COURT:
- 1. Petitioner Capp Peterson Taylor is hereby reinstated to the practice of law in the State of Tennessee pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 30.4(d).
- 2. Pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 24.3, Mr. Taylor shall pay to the Board of Professional Responsibility the expenses and costs of this matter in the amount of \$750.00 and shall pay to the Clerk of this Court the costs incurred herein within ninety (90) days of the entry of this Order, for all of which execution may issue if necessary.
- 3. The Board of Professional Responsibility shall cause notice of this reinstatement to be published as required by Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 28.11.
