**KNOXVILLE LAWYER SUSPENDED**

On September 21, 2011, Lisa Anne Temple of Knoxville, Tennessee, was suspended by the Tennessee Supreme Court for a period of four (4) years retroactive to her temporary suspension on March 19, 2010, and ordered to enter into a Tennessee Lawyers Assistance Program (TLAP) monitoring agreement and abide by that agreement.

On April 28, 2010, the Board filed a Petition for Discipline against Ms. Temple based upon three (3) complaints that Ms. Temple practiced law while suspended for continuing legal education noncompliance. On September 20, 2010, the Board filed a Supplemental Petition for Discipline against Ms. Temple alleging she had made misrepresentations to a client, had failed to advise the client of the suspension and had neglected the client's case. On December 22, 2010, the Board filed a Second Supplemental Petition for Discipline against Ms. Temple charging her with forging her former partner's signature to a settlement agreement and Agreed Order filed with the Anderson County Chancery Court. Ms. Temple's actions violate Rules of Professional Conduct 1.3 (diligence); 1.4 (communication); 1.5 (fees); 1.16 (terminating representation); 5.5 (unauthorized practice); 8.1 (disciplinary matters) and 8.4 (misconduct).

Ms. Temple was ordered to pay the expenses and costs of the disciplinary proceeding against her pursuant to Rule 9, Section 4.7 of the Rules of the Supreme Court, and was ordered to fully comply in all respects with the requirements and obligations of suspended attorneys as set forth in Rule 9, Section 18 of the Rules of the Supreme Court.

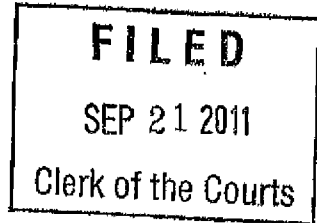

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**ORDER OF ENFORCEMENT**

This matter is before the Court upon a Petition for Discipline filed April 28, 2010 by the Board of Professional Responsibility ("Board") against Lisa Ann Temple; upon Ms. Temple's Answer to Petition for Discipline filed May 20, 2010; upon the Board's Supplemental Petition for Discipline filed September 20, 2010; upon the Board's Motion for Default Judgment filed October 21, 2010; upon the Hearing Panel's Order granting the Board's Motion for Default Judgment filed December 9, 2010; upon the Board's Second Supplemental Petition for Discipline filed December 22, 2010; upon Ms. Temple's Response to Second Supplemental Petition for Discipline filed February 10, 2010; upon Ms. Temple's Conditional Guilty Plea filed August 18, 2011; and upon an Order Recommending Approval of Conditional Guilty Plea entered by the Hearing Panel on August 22, 2011; upon consideration and approval of the Board on September 9, 2011; and upon the entire record in this cause.

From all of which the Court approves the Order of the Hearing Panel and adopts the Order of the Hearing Panel as the Court's Order.

By Order entered March 19, 2010, in Case No. M2010-00595-SC-BPR-BP, Ms. Temple was temporarily suspended from the practice of law pursuant to Tennessee Supreme Court Rule 9, Section 4.3. To date, Ms. Temple has not been granted reinstatement.

It is therefore, **ORDERED, ADJUDGED** and **DECREED** by the Court that:

1. Lisa Ann Temple, is hereby suspended for four (4) years retroactive to her temporary suspension on March 19, 2010, and her agreement to enter into a Tennessee Lawyers Assistance Program (TLAP) monitoring agreement and abide by the terms of that agreement.

2. The suspension shall become effective ten (10) days after the filing of this Order.

3. Lisa Temple shall comply in all aspects with Supreme Court Rule 9, Section 18 regarding the obligations and responsibilities of suspended attorneys. Ms. Temple must meet all CLE requirements and all registration requirements prior to reinstatement.

4. Upon entry of this Order, the Order of Temporary Suspension entered March 19, 2010 is hereby dissolved.

5. Pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 9, Section 24.3, Ms. Temple shall pay to the Board of Professional Responsibility the expenses and costs of this matter in the amount of \$2,473.00, within ninety (90) days of the entry of this Order, for all of which execution may issue if necessary.

6. The Board shall cause notice of this suspension to be published as required by Supreme Court Rule 9, Section 18.10.
