PUBLIC CENSURE

The above complaint was filed against John Terence Tennyson, an attorney licensed to practice law in Tennessee, alleging certain acts of misconduct. Pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 9, the Board of Professional Responsibility considered this matter at its meeting on March 13, 2020.

Mr. Tennyson failed to comply with the conditions of a prior Public Censure requiring him to reimburse funds to a former client within a prescribed period of time. Mr. Tennyson did ultimately provide the former client with the required amount of reimbursed funds but was over 100 days delinquent in his compliance with such obligation.

By the aforementioned acts, John Terence Tennyson has violated Rule of Professional Conduct 3.4(c) (disobeying an obligation under the rules of a tribunal) and 8.4(a) and (d) (misconduct) and is hereby Publicly Censured for these violations.
