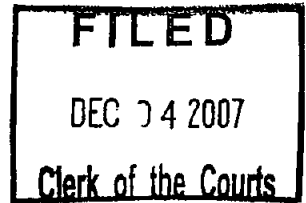

ORDER OF ENFORCEMENT

This cause is before the Court upon a Petition for Reinstatement filed by Petitioner, Kevin Shalom Terry, on January 19, 2005, pursuant to Section 19 of Supreme Court Rule 9. By Order of Enforcement entered August 1, 2006, this Court ordered that:

1. Petitioner shall be reinstated to the practice of law upon certification by the Board of Law Examiners that Petitioner has taken and successfully completed the essay portion of the bar examination as provided in Article IV of Supreme Court Rule 7;

2. Upon resumption of the practice of law, Petitioner shall practice for one year in a group practice setting as approved by the Board of Professional Responsibility (hereinafter referred to as the "Board");

3. Petitioner shall comply with a contract which he entered into on October 21, 2003, with the Tennessee Lawyers Assistance Program (hereinafter referred to as "TLAP") for a term of five years.

4. Upon resumption of the practice of law, Petitioner shall enter into and strictly comply with a law practice monitoring/mentoring agreement with a practicing attorney approved by the Board, the said agreement to be effective for a period of three years from the date of Petitioner's reinstatement to the practice of law.


It now appearing to the Court that the Board of Law Examiners has provided to the Board certification that Petitioner has successfully completed the essay portion of the bar examination; and


It further appearing to the Court that Petitioner entered into a practice monitoring/mentoring agreement on August 13, 2007, and that the agreement has been approved by the Board.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED, ADJUDGED, and DECREED by the COURT:

1. That Petitioner is reinstated to the practice of law upon entry of this Order.
2. That Petitioner shall practice for a minimum of one year from the date of entry of this Order in a group practice setting, defined as the practice of law within a governmental or corporate law office, law firm, a PC or PLLC, or in an office practice with two or more attorneys.
3. That Petitioner shall continue to remain in compliance with the five- year TLAP contract Petitioner entered into on October 21, 2003. Notwithstanding any prior order to the contrary, TLAP shall report to the Board any substantial non-compliance by Petitioner with any of the terms and conditions of Petitioner's TLAP contract.
4. That Petitioner shall strictly comply with the law practice monitoring/mentoring agreement approved by the Board on August 13, 2007, said agreement to be in effect for a minimum period of three years from the date of entry of this Order.
5. That Petitioner, Kevin Shalom Terry, shall pay the costs of these proceedings in the sum of \$4,484.00 and, in addition, shall pay the Clerk of this Court the costs incurred, for all of which execution shall issue, if necessary.
