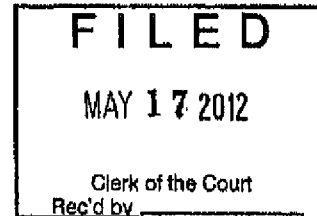

**ORDER**

On April 24, 2012, this Court filed an order giving the appellant, John O. Threadgill, ten (10) days to file an acceptable bond for costs in accordance with Rule 6 of the Tennessee Rules of Appellate Procedure and to comply with Tennessee Rule of Appellate Procedure 24(b), (c), or (d), or else show cause why this appeal should not be dismissed.

The appellant has failed to file an acceptable bond or to comply with Rule 24 (b), (c), or (d). Accordingly, this appeal is **DISMISSED**. Costs associated with this appeal are taxed to the appellant for which execution may, if necessary, issue.

Because the March 22, 2011 judgment of the Hearing Panel includes a sanction greater than a three-month suspension and because no appeal from that judgment has been properly perfected, the Board of Professional Responsibility is directed to forward a copy of the Hearing Panel's judgment for review by this Court in accordance with Tennessee Supreme Court Rule 9, section 8.4.

It is so **ORDERED**.
