JUDGMENT

This case was heard upon the record on appeal from the Chancery Court for Knox County, the briefs of the parties, and argument of counsel. Upon consideration thereof, this Court concludes that the judgment of the Chancery Court for Knox County upholding the Hearing Panel's decision is affirmed, and Mr. Threadgill is disbarred from the practice of law in Tennessee, which disbarment is to be effective ten days after the entry of this Court's disbarment order. *See* Tenn.
