ORDER



John Threadgill filed a Petition for Certiorari appealing a Hearing Panel's Judgment following a February 23, 2011 hearing upon a Petition for Discipline and Supplemental Petition filed by the Board. The Court finds that the Board's Motion to Dismiss for Failure to Prosecute is well-taken and Mr. Threadgill's appeal is hereby dismissed.



AMENDED ORDER


