PUBLIC CENSURE

The above complaint was filed against Chadwick Barry Tindell, an attorney licensed to practice law in Tennessee, alleging certain acts of misconduct. Pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, the Board of Professional Responsibility considered these matters at its meeting on June 14, 2013.

Chadwick Barry Tindell pled guilty to facilitation of official misconduct in conjunction with his role in the Knox County Trustee giving improper bonuses to employees. Mr. Tindell's conduct violated Rule 8.4(b) because the criminal act adversely reflected on his honesty, trustworthiness, or fitness as a lawyer in other respects.

By the aforementioned acts, Chadwick Barry Tindell has violated Rule of Professional Conduct 8.4(b) (misconduct) and is hereby Publicly Censured for this violation.
