PUBLIC CENSURE



Mr. Turner practiced law for five business days when his license was administratively suspended, including an appearance in court at a hearing.

By the aforementioned acts, Mr. Turner is in violation of Rule 5.5 (unauthorized practice of law) of the Rules of Professional Conduct and is hereby Publicly Censured on these violations
