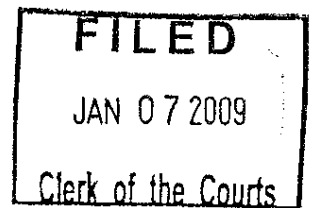

**ORDER OF REINSTATEMENT**


This matter is before the Court upon a Petition for Dissolution of Temporary Suspension filed by Gary Wayne Vandever ("Respondent"); upon a hearing before a duly appointed Hearing Panel of the Board of Professional Responsibility (the "Board") on December 22, 2008; upon the Order of Recommendation of the Hearing Panel entered on December 29, 2008; and upon the entire record of this cause.

From all of which the Court adopts the findings and recommendations of the Hearing Panel and finds that reinstatement is appropriate.

It is, therefore, **ORDERED, ADJUDGED** and **DECREED** by the Court that:

1. The Petition for Dissolution of Temporary Suspension filed by Respondent is hereby granted and Respondent shall be reinstated to the practice of law upon full payment of the Board's costs in the amount of \$650.00 as required by Rule 9, Section 24.3 of the Rules of the Supreme Court.
2. Respondent shall pay to the Clerk of this Court the costs incurred herein, for all of which execution may issue, if necessary.
3. The Board shall cause notice of this reinstatement to be published by the method outlined in Rule 9, Section 18.10 of the Rules of the Supreme Court
