ORDER OF TEMPORARY SUSPENSION

- That Gary Wayne Vandever may make application for dissolution or modification of this Order as provided in Supreme Court Rule 9.
- That the Board of Professional Responsibility shall cause notice of this suspension of Gary Wayne Vandever to be published as required by Supreme Court Rule 9.
