ORDER OF ENFORCEMENT

R. 9, § 22.3, upon a Notice of Submission filed by Disciplinary Counsel for the Board of Professional Responsibility consisting of a certified copy of the Judgment in a Criminal Case in the Criminal Court for Washington County, Tennessee, in the matter of State of Tennessee v. Kyle D. Vaughan, Case Number: 46339 (attached as Exhibit A), demonstrating Kyle Douglas Vaughan, a Tennessee licensed attorney, pled guilty to a serious crime, i.e., Theft of Property over \$60,000 and under \$250,000 in violation of T.C.A. § 39-14-103.

IT IS THEREFORE, CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED BY THE COURT THAT:

- 1. Kyle Douglas Vaughan is suspended from the practice of law pending further orders of this Court, pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 22.3;
- 2. This matter shall be referred to the Board of Professional Responsibility for the institution of formal proceedings in which the sole issue to be determined shall be the extent of the final discipline;
- 3. Kyle Douglas Vaughan shall fully comply with the provisions of Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 28, concerning disbarred or suspended attorneys; and
- 4. The Board of Professional Responsibility shall cause notice of this suspension to be published as required by Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 28.11.
