ORDER OF TEMPORARY SUSPENSION

This matter is before the Court upon a Petition of the Board of Professional Responsibility of the Supreme Court of Tennessee, by and through Disciplinary Counsel, for the temporary suspension of David Arthur Walker from the practice of law pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 12.3. The Petition has been authorized by the Chair of the Board of Professional Responsibility and is supported by the Declaration of Lauren Castor, Interim Executive Director of the Tennessee Lawyers Assistance Program.

Based upon the Petition and the supporting Declaration, the Court finds that David Arthur Walker, Respondent, is substantially non-compliant with a Tennessee Lawyers Assistance Program monitoring agreement as detailed by the Declaration of Lauren Castor and poses a threat of substantial harm to the public.

IT IS, THEREFORE, CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED BY THE COURT THAT:

1. David Arthur Walker is hereby temporarily suspended from the practice of law as provided in Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 12.3.
2. David Arthur Walker shall comply with Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9 in all respects and particularly as provided in Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 28, regarding the responsibilities of suspended attorneys.
3. David Arthur Walker may make application for dissolution or modification of this Order as provided in Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 12.3.
4. The Board of Professional Responsibility shall cause notice of this suspension of David Arthur Walker to be published as required by Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 28.11.
