**MAURY COUNTY LAWYER TRANSFERRED TO ACTIVE STATUS**

By Order of the Tennessee Supreme Court entered December 10, 2020, the law license of Angela Kay Washington was transferred from disability inactive status to active status pursuant to Section 27.7 of Tennessee Supreme Court Rule 9.

On June 12, 2020, Ms. Washington was placed on disability inactive status. Ms. Washington filed a Petition for Transfer to Active Status on December 8, 2020, demonstrating she no longer suffered from a disability. By Order of the Tennessee Supreme Court, Ms. Washington is immediately eligible to resume the active practice of law in the State of Tennessee.

**ORDER OF REINSTATEMENT**

This matter is before the Court, pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 27.7, upon a Petition for Reinstatement Pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, Section 27.7, filed on December 8, 2020, by the Petitioner, Angela Kay Washington. Ms. Washington's law license was transferred to disability inactive status by Order of this Court on June 12, 2020. The Board of Professional Responsibility's Response to the Petition for Reinstatement of Law License was filed noting no objection to the Petition for Reinstatement.

3. The Board of Professional Responsibility shall cause notice of this reinstatement to be published as required by Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 28.11.
