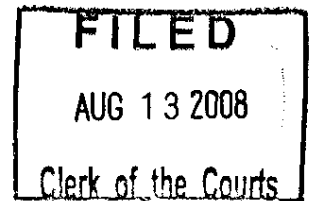

ORDER OF ENFORCEMENT

This matter is before the Court upon a Petition for Discipline filed against Respondent, James M. Webster, by the Board of Professional Responsibility ("the Board") on September 14, 2004; upon a Supplemental Petition for Discipline filed against Respondent on August 11, 2005; upon a Second Supplemental Petition for Discipline filed against Respondent on May 24, 2006; upon a Third Supplemental Petition for Discipline filed against Respondent on October 29, 2006; upon the Judgment of the Hearing Committee filed on January 30, 2008; and upon the entire record in this cause.


From all of which the Court approves the Judgment of the Hearing Committee and incorporates the recommendations contained therein as the Court's Order.

It is, therefore, **ORDERED, ADJUDGED, and DECREED** by the Court that:

1. Respondent is suspended from the practice of law for six (6) months.
2. Respondent shall pay restitution as follows:
 - a. Restitution in the sum of \$750.00 to Jeffrey David Phillips;
 - b. Restitution in the sum of \$1,000.00 to Bonnie Douglas; and
 - c. Restitution in the sum of \$1,500.00 to John Blakely.
3. The payment of restitution shall be a condition of reinstatement.
4. Pursuant to Rule 9, § 24.3 of the Rules of the Supreme Court, Respondent shall pay to the Board the expenses and costs of this matter in the amount of \$4,113.34, and in addition, shall pay to the Clerk of this Court the costs incurred herein, for all of which execution may issue, if necessary.

5. The Board shall cause notice of this suspension to be published as required by Rule 9, § 18.10 of the Rules of the Supreme Court.
