PUBLIC CENSURE

The above complaint was filed against John Scott Wesson, #020555, an attorney licensed to practice law in Tennessee, alleging certain acts of misconduct. Pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, the Board of Professional Responsibility considered these matters at its meeting on March 11, 2022.

Mr. Wesson failed to appear at a deposition, failed to file a response to opposing counsel's motion for summary judgment, and failed to appear at several court hearings. Mr. Wesson failed to maintain good communication with his client during the representation. Moreover, Mr. Wesson was named as a party in a show cause proceeding, and the court found him in civil contempt.

By these acts, Mr. Wesson has violated Rules of Professional Conduct 1.3 (diligence), 1.4 (communication), and 8.4(g) (misconduct), and is hereby Publicly Censured for these violations. This Public Censure is conditioned on Mr. Wesson's completion of a Tennessee Lawyers Assistance Program monitoring agreement with mandatory reporting to Disciplinary Counsel.
