BEDFORD COUNTY LAWYER REINSTATED

On December 6, 2019, the Supreme Court of Tennessee reinstated Christopher Paul Westmoreland to active practice provided he retains a practice monitor during his remaining probationary period and does not incur any new complaints of misconduct that relate to conduct occurring during the period of suspension. Mr. Westmoreland had been suspended by the Supreme Court of Tennessee on October 16, 2019, for a period of nine (9) months, with one (1) month active suspension and the remainder on probation, pursuant to Tennessee Supreme Court Rule 9, Section 12.2. Mr. Westmoreland filed a Petition for Reinstatement to the practice of law pursuant to Tennessee Supreme Court Rule 9, Section 30.4c. The Board found the Petition satisfactory and submitted an Order of Reinstatement to the Court.

ORDER OF REINSTATEMENT

This matter is before the Court, pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 30.4(c), upon a Petition for Reinstatement filed on November 5, 2019, by the Petitioner, Christopher P. Westmoreland. Mr. Christopher P. Westmoreland was suspended from the practice of law by Order of this Court on October 16, 2019, for a period of nine (9) months, with one (1) month of active suspension, and the remaining to be served on probation. A Notice of Submission was filed by Chief Disciplinary Counsel indicating that the petition is satisfactory to the Board and Mr. Christopher P. Westmoreland has satisfied all conditions set forth in the Order imposing discipline and that he is eligible for reinstatement.

From all of which the Court grants the Petition for Reinstatement.

IT IS, THEREFORE, CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED BY THE COURT:

1. The Petitioner, Christopher P. Westmoreland, is hereby reinstated to the practice of law in the State of Tennessee pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 30.4(c).
2. Mr. Christopher P. Westmoreland shall pay to the Clerk of this Court the costs incurred herein within ninety (90) days of the entry of this Order, for which execution may issue if necessary.
3. The Board of Professional Responsibility shall cause notice of this reinstatement to be published as required by Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 28.11.
