ORDER DISSOLVING TEMPORARY SUSPENSION

On November 12, 2025, an Order of Temporary Suspension was entered against Edward Kendall White for failing to respond to the Board concerning a complaint of misconduct. On November 18, 2025, Mr. White filed a petition which in substance sought dissolution of the order of temporary suspension pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, section 12.3(d) and reinstatement. As grounds for this relief, Mr. White demonstrated that he had responded to the disciplinary complaint and had complied with all conditions imposed by the Order of Temporary Suspension.

On November 19, 2025, the Board filed an Answer to the petition in which the Board admitted receiving a response to the disciplinary complaint from Petitioner, which Disciplinary Counsel deemed sufficient. The Board's response further submitted that, considering the present circumstances in this matter, no hearing on the petition for dissolution under Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, section 12.3(d) was necessary.

Based upon the foregoing facts and circumstances, the Court is satisfied that it is unnecessary to hold a hearing on the petition under Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, section 12.3(d) and that Mr. White is entitled to immediate dissolution of the temporary suspension.

IT IS, THEREFORE, CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED BY THE COURT THAT:

1. The temporary suspension imposed upon Edward Kendall White by Order of Temporary Suspension entered November 12, 2025, is hereby dissolved.

2. The Board of Professional Responsibility shall cause notice of this reinstatement to be published as required by Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 28.11.
