PUBLIC CENSURE




The above complaint was filed against Quenton White, an attorney licensed to practice law in Tennessee, alleging certain acts of misconduct. Pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, the Board of Professional Responsibility considered these matters at its meeting on December 14, 2012.

On August 8, 2012, Mr. White's license to practice law was suspended for IOLTA noncompliance and failure to pay the annual registration fee. Mr. White continued to practice law while suspended and continued to hold himself out as a practicing attorney on his website. Mr. White's law license was returned to active status on September 13, 2012.

By the aforementioned acts, Mr. White has violated Rule of Professional Conduct 5.5 (unauthorized practice of law) and is hereby Publicly Censured for this violation.
