PUBLIC CENSURE

The above complaint was filed against Candace Lenette Williamson, an attorney licensed

to practice law in Tennessee, alleging certain acts of misconduct. Pursuant to Supreme Court

Rule 9, the Board of Professional Responsibility considered these matters at its meeting on

September 11, 2020.

Ms. Williamson was paid a fee to represent a client but neglected to take any substantive

legal action on behalf of the client. Ms. Williamson deceived the client into believing that she had

filed petitions in both Mississippi and Tennessee, but no petitions were ever filed. Ms. Williamson

thereafter abandoned the representation and failed to respond to the disciplinary complaint against

her.

By the aforementioned acts, Candace Lenette Williamson has violated Rule of Professional

Conduct 1.3 (diligence), 1.4 (communication), 1.5 (fees), 1.16 (terminating representation), 8.1(b)

(disciplinary matters) and 8.4(a)(c)(d) (misconduct), and is hereby Publicly Censured for these

violations.
