## CORRECTED ORDER TRANSFERRING ATTORNEY TO DISABILITY INACTIVE STATUS

This matter is before the Court upon a petition to transfer Johnny Leon Woodruff to disability inactive status filed by the Tennessee Board of Professional Responsibility pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 27.3.

Upon due consideration of documentation from Mr. Woodruff and his medical providers, the Court concludes that Johnny Leon Woodruff is currently incapacitated from continuing the practice of law and is unable to defend against disciplinary complaints pending before the Board.

IT IS, THEREFORE, CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED BY THE COURT THAT:

- 1. The law license of Johnny Leon Woodruff shall be transferred to disability inactive status for an indefinite period of time and until further order of the Supreme Court. All disciplinary complaints pending before the Board shall be stayed until further order of this Court.
- 2. Mr. Woodruff shall be allowed to petition for reinstatement to active status pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 27.7.
- 3. The Board shall publish notice of this transfer pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, §§ 27.5 and 28.11.
- 4. Pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 32.4, documents other than this Order relating to Mr. Woodruff's disability proceeding shall not be public records and shall be kept confidential.
