CORRECTED ORDER OF ENFORCEMENT

This matter is before the Court upon a Petition for Discipline filed against Jonathan Lee Young on October 5, 2023; upon Answer to Petition for Discipline filed by Mr. Young on November 1, 2023; upon a Conditional Guilty Plea filed by Mr. Young on April 22, 2024; upon the Hearing Panel's Order Recommending Approval of Conditional Guilty Plea entered April 23, 2024; upon consideration and approval by the Board of Professional Responsibility on June 14, 2024; and upon the entire record in this cause.

From all of which, the Court approves the Order of the Hearing Panel and adopts the Order Recommending Approval of Conditional Guilty Plea as the Court's Order.

IT IS, THEREFORE, CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED BY THE COURT THAT:

(1) Pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 12.4, Jonathan Lee Young is hereby publicly censured.

(2) Pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 31.3(d), and the Conditional Guilty Plea, Mr. Young, shall pay to the Board of Professional Responsibility the expenses and costs incurred to date by the Board in this matter in the amount of \$440.00 which includes an assessment of \$100.00 for the cost of filing this matter and pay this filing fee to the Board and shall pay to the Clerk of this Court the court costs incurred herein. All costs, fees, and expenses awarded or assessed herein shall be paid within ninety (90) days of the entry of this Order for which execution, if necessary, may issue.

(3) In the event Mr. Young fails to fully comply with this Order of Enforcement, the Board may reopen the disciplinary complaint and conduct further disciplinary proceedings in accordance with Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 12.8.

(4) The Board of Professional Responsibility shall cause notice of this discipline to be published.

(5) Pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 28.1, this Order shall be effective upon entry.
